His work builds on an abundant experience, knowledge and skills within both medicine understanding the nature of diseases and how they impact individuals, as well as pedagogical and didactic training working both with research, pregraduate curriculum design and development, implementation and informatics.



Professor Ralph Maddison

Ralph Maddison is Professor of Physical Activity for Disease Prevention and Management at Deakin University's Institute for Physical Activity and Nutrition. He leads the digital health cross domain research theme within IPAN. He is a behavioural scientist with expertise in the design, development, and management of digital interventions for supporting change in lifestyle risk factors for people with chronic disease, including cardiovascular disease and diabetes.
